We are pleased to announce that The Hershey Company's 2023-2024 Season of Giving annual workplace giving campaign will take place from November 1 through November 30<sup>th</sup>. This year, **retirees may donate to one of six charities and your donation will be matched dollar for dollar up to \$10,000 by the company.** As you know, our employees and retirees contribute generously during each campaign. Last year, we raised nearly \$1.7 million, which directly benefited our local communities and people in need.

Retirees may donate to any of the charities below during our Season of Giving to be eligible for a dollar-for-dollar match from The Hershey Company:

- The Hershey Company Employees 1<sup>st</sup> Fund

As in previous years, **your donation must be entered ONLINE** to be eligible for company matching dollars. **Please do not send checks to The Hershey Company.** There are two ways to use the online giving portal:

1. **Upload Your Receipt:** Donate directly to one of the charities listed above and then upload your receipt from the charity to the online portal during the campaign to have your gift matched. The portal will be open from November 1 – November 30<sup>th</sup>. All contributions to the charity must be made between January 1 – November 30, 2023 to be eligible for the match.
2. **Give via the Portal:** You can also make your donation by credit card to one of the charities via the portal, and your gift will automatically be matched.
